Kids' Kamp Frequently Asked Questions for Parents and Campers:

When should we arrive?

Arrive between 5:00 and 6:30 pm on Friday. Our first session starts at 7:00pm. Don't miss it! Your church will plan transportation and let you know when to be ready to go to get to Kamp on time.

What meals are served?

Please have your Friday dinner BEFORE you arrive! (There will be a small snack Friday night during learning time.) Meals will be served in the cafeteria for Saturday: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner. For Sunday: Breakfast and Lunch.

When will camp end?

Camp ends after lunch on Sunday. **ALL CAMPERS and STAFF LEAVE KAMP BY 1:00 PM**

How will cabins be assigned?

As part of the experience of Kids' Kamp, *campers will be assigned to cabins based on gender and age, to help them make more friends from other churches.* We want this to be a time of new friendships and new adventures. Many of these new relationships will last a lifetime. They do have the opportunity to choose one bunkmate. Most activities group the children together, so children always see familiar faces.

Who are the counselors?

Every counselor is someone recommended by their home church pastor. All have passed the LIVESCAN background check for the safety of our children.

What happens at Kids' Kamp?

Camp includes Bible stories, group building activities, fun physical activities (including archery and zip line), crafts, games, songs, and the opportunity to experience the outdoors. Most importantly, children have the opportunity to learn more about God, scripture, prayer, and salvation.

What do I need to pack?

Closed toe shoes (not just flip-flops!), **swimsuit** (girls: one piece or with T-shirt cover), pants, shirts, jacket or sweatshirt, underwear, socks, pajamas (or shorts & t-shirt), **sleeping bag** or bedding, **pillow**, washcloth, towel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, comb or brush. Bring your Bible, a notepad, flashlight, sunscreen, and insect repellent.

What should I leave at home?

Don't bring any ipods, earbuds or video games. All cell phones will be on airplane mode, except for Pastor Collett's phone, whose number is listed below. We want to focus on God. Your phone or camera can be used for some pictures at Kamp, but **NO POSTING TO SOCIAL MEDIA.**

Do I need to bring money?

It's OK to have a little money for the gift shop, but it is not needed.

What if I have an emergency and need to contact my child?
