Church Leader's Kids' Kamp Checklist /FAQ:

- ☐ Camp registration form and camper's fee with Association Medical Info /waiver
- ☐ Palomar Conference Center Release Form.
- ☐ Counselor Application and registration form, and counselor camper's fee, with Association Medical Info/waiver.
- ☐ Palomar Conference Center Release Form.
- ☐ Signed Photo Use Agreement forms for children and adults.

FOR ADULT LEADERS: Be sure that the LIVE SCAN background check has been completed, the application signed, and a copy of the LIVE SCAN card sent to the Association.

- ☐ Copy all forms and keep one for travel. Send the forms with payment to the Association office by June 22, 2026. *After that date, bring all signed forms and payment with you to Kamp.*
- ☐ Bring at least 1 counselor for every 5 children - Please consider the balance of girls and boys.
- ☐ Provide transportation for people and gear, to and from camp.
- ☐ Copies of registration forms for everyone.
- ☐ *For any last-minute enrollment, bring the original registration and release forms and payment.*
- ☐ Plan to make sure everyone has dinner on Friday before they arrive at camp. (We will provide a snack only)

Items Needed at Kamp:

- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Sleeping bag or bedding, Pillow
- ☐ Closed toe shoes (flip-flops for pool only)
- ☐ Pants, shirts, sweatshirt or jacket
- ☐ Pajamas (or shorts and t-shirt)
- ☐ Swimsuit, and pool shirt if needed for bikini
- ☐ Towel and washcloth
- ☐ Underwear, socks
- ☐ Soap, shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste, deodorant
- ☐ Comb or brush,
- ☐ Sunscreen, insect repellent,
- ☐ Bible

Frequently Asked Questions

about Kids' Kamp

When should we arrive? Arrive by 6:30 pm on Friday evening. Our first session begins at 7:00 pm. You can also check to see if your church is providing any transportation.

What meals are served? Friday evening - snack provided by Children's Ministries Team. Saturday: Breakfast, lunch, dinner. Sunday: Breakfast, lunch.

When does Kids' Kamp end? Kamp ends after lunch on Sunday. ALL CAMPERS AND STAFF LEAVE KAMP BY 1:00 PM.

Who are the counselors? Every counselor is someone recommended by their home church Pastor. All have passed the LIVE SCAN background check for the safety of our children.

What should campers leave at home? Electronic items. All cell phones, including counselors and staff, will be on airplane mode, except for Pastor Dave Collett's phone. (626) 922-4766. Phones can be used for pictures at camp, but there is NO POSTING TO SOCIAL MEDIA. We want to focus during this time on our lives with Christ.

Do campers need any money? Money is not required, but campers may bring money for snacks or gifts from a small gift store on campus if preferred.

What happens at Kids' Kamp? Kids' Kamp includes Bible stories, group building activities, fun physical activities,(including zipline and archery), crafts, games, songs, and the opportunity to experience the outdoors. Most importantly, children have the opportunity to learn more about God, scripture, prayer, and salvation.
